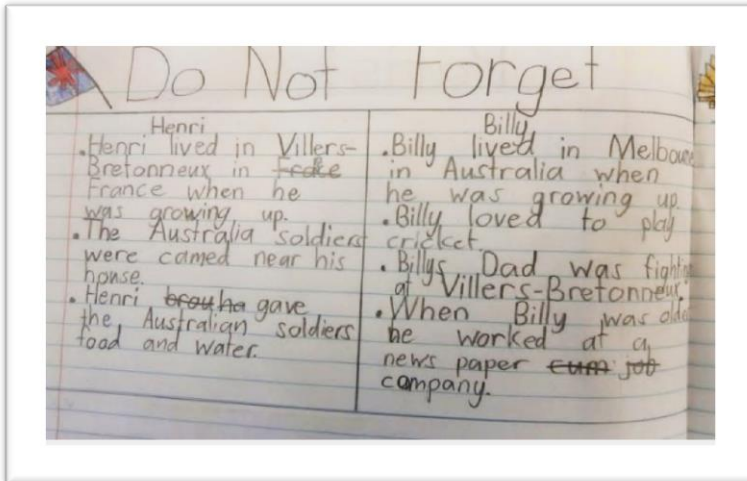


## FRENCH ROOM FOCUS
